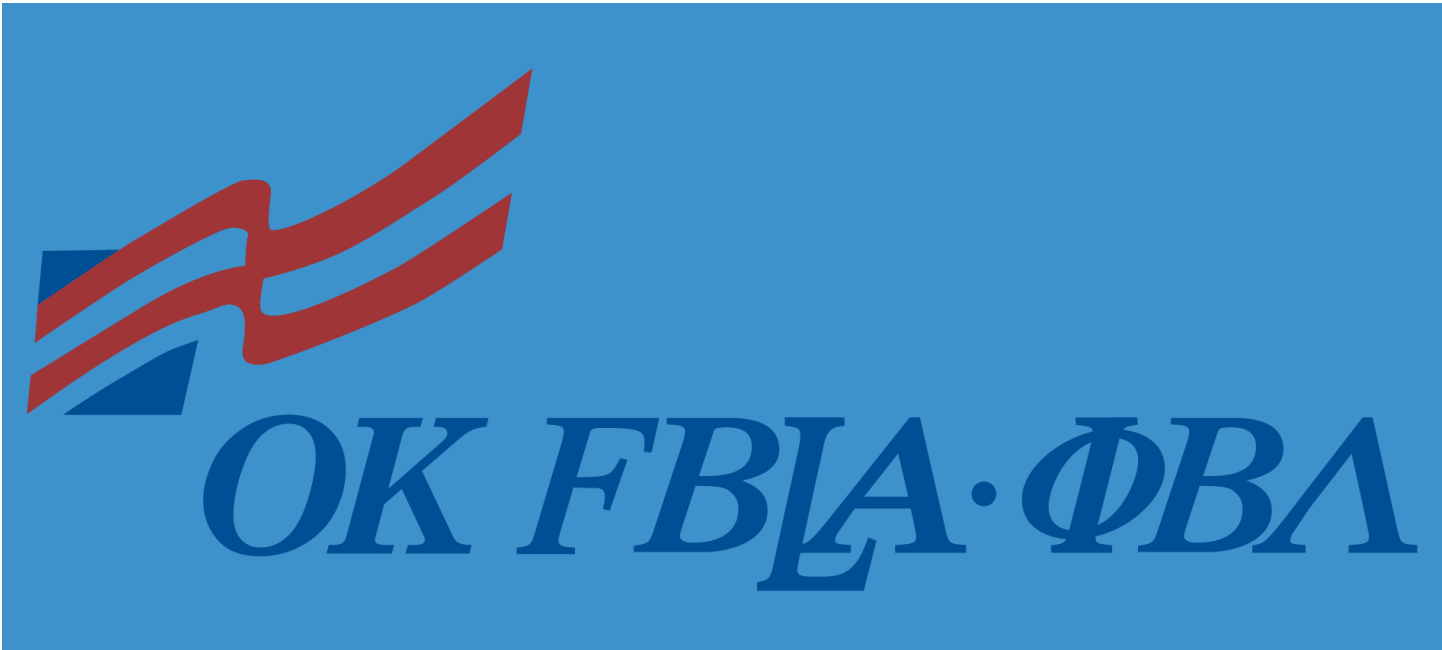

To all those who competed at the National Conference, congratulations for all your hard work and dedication.

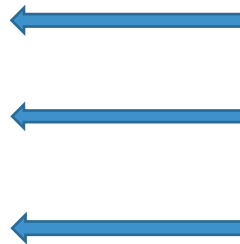


Fall conference will be held at two different locations on November 16th from 10am-3pm. Cost is \$40 per attendee (lunch included).
